Noted for his “astounding technical proficiency and artistic delicacy” by the Boston Musical Intelligencer, Aaron Larget-Caplan is a recording and international touring artist. A talented speaker and missionary of live music, he regularly performs solo, and with chamber ensemble and orchestra. He has premiered over 80 compositions, directed a concert series, created educational programs, and his arrangements of John Cage are published by Edition Peters. Aaron is on faculty at the University of Massachusetts Boston, and formerly the Boston Conservatory.

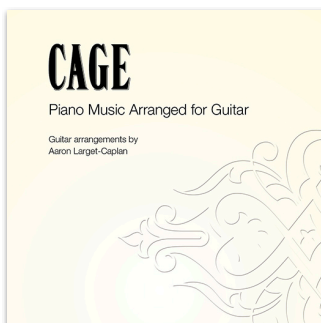

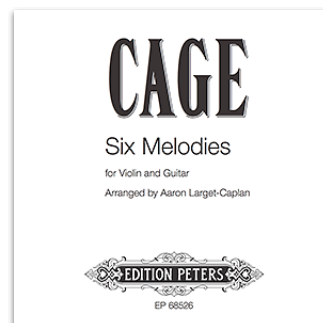
